APPLICANT

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublings. County Council, being the Planning Pair 169 for the County Herrical Fermission District of Dublin, did by order deted decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act to grant an approval for Proposed temporary classroom and staff block to

THE SECOND OF SECOND SECOND

- Tallaght Technical School.

(1) That the structure shall be removed on or before 31st August, 1974, unless before that date permission for its retention is granted by the Planning Authority or by the Hinister on appeal.

(2) That the requirements of the Council's Fire Prevention Officer, if any, be adhered

to in the development.

(3) That the water supply and drainage arrangements, if any, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.

(4) That adequate off-street car parking facilities associated with any additional staff be provided.

Reasons for conditions:

(1) To enable the effect of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed, having regard to the conditions then obtaining.

(2) In the interests of public safety and avoidance of fire hazard.

(3) In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.

(4) In the interests of Kthe proper Planning and develop-

ment of the area.

If there is no appeal to the Minister for Local Government against this decision permission ill be granted by the Council on the expiration of the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in accordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the permissions soon as may be after the withdrawal.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appeallant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary, Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for appearance as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
