In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/127/69 dated 25th July, 1969. make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act refusing outline permission for: Proposed Hotel and Four Shops at "Fortrose", Templeogue Road, Templeogue.

for the following reasons:-

- (1) The proposed development on this site, located on a substandard road bend with limited vision on a heavily trafficked arterial route, would generate heavy extra traffic and turning movements and would create a serious traffic hazard.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the applicant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary, Department of Local Government, (Planning Appeals Section), Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for outline permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
