In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin  
County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health  
District of Dublin, did by order P/150/69 dated 25th May, 1969  
make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act to grant an

Approval for:

Proposed extension of premises at Donmulla, at Atroc.

subject to the following conditions:-

(1) That building approval shall be  
obtained and any conditions of such  
approval shall be observed in the  
development.

(1) In order to comply with the  
Sanitary Services Acts, 1973-1974.

If there is no appeal to the Minister for Local Government against this  
decision, approval will be granted by the Council on the expiration of  
the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in  
accordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the  
approval as soon as may be after the withdrawal.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the  
applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of  
this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the  
date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the  
subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of  
appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed  
to the Secretary, Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1.  
If an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister  
of Local Government will determine the application for approval as if it  
been made to him in the first instance.

APPROVAL OF THE COUNCIL UNDER BUILDING BYE LAWS MUST BE OBTAINED BEFORE  
DEVELOPMENT IS COMMENCED AND THE TERMS OF APPROVAL MUST BE COMPLIED WITH  
CARRYING OUT OF THE WORK.
