for the following reasons:-

(1) The proposed site is located in an area which is likely to be affected by major interchange proposals for the Dublin/Maas and the Tallaght/Clondalkin/Lucan arterial routes.

(2) There ar no public piped sewerage facilities available to

(3) The proposed development would be premature by reason of the said existing deficiency in the provision of severage facilities and the period within which such deficiency may reasonably be expected to be made good.

(4) The proposed site is considered too small for septic tank drainage as the proposed house is located in close proximity to the existing septic tank which serves the existing bungalow.
