<p>(1) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.</p> <p>(2) That the necessary lands at the south side of the site be reserved for the Lucan By-pass Road Improvement Scheme.</p> <p>(3) That the external finishes, including the roofs, harmonise in colour and texture with the existing development.</p> <p>(4) That Building Bye Laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.</p> <p>If there is no appeal to the Minister for Local Government against this decision, approval <u>Permission</u> will be granted by the Council on the expiration of the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in accordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the approval <u>Permission</u> as soon as may be after the withdrawal.</p>	<p>(1) To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.</p> <p>(2) In the interests of proper Planning and Development of the site.</p> <p>(3) In the interests of visual amenity.</p> <p>(4) In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.</p>

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary, Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for approval as if it had been made to him in the first instance.

APPROVAL OF THE COUNCIL UNDER BUILDING BYE LAWS MUST BE OBTAINED BEFORE THE DEVELOPMENT IS COMMENCED AND THE TERMS OF APPROVAL MUST BE COMPLIED WITH IN THE CARRYING OUT OF THE WORK.
