APPLICANT Dundrum Recreation Centre.

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order p/1402/69 dated 22nd August, 1969 make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act refusing outline permission for:

Proposed Recreation Centre at Ballinteer, Dundrum.

for the following reasons:-

- (1) The proposed development, located on lands acquired by the County Council as Sanitary Authority for public recreational and ancillary purposes, is premature because (a) the specific uses for these lands have not yet been decided by the Sanitary Authority, (b) the consent of the Sanitary Authority to the uses now proposed by the applicants has not been given (c) the applicants have no interest or rights in these lands at present.

NOTE: The applicants are advised to consult with the Sanitary Authority, through the County Secretary, No. 11, Parnell Square, before submitting any further revised proposals.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the applicant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary, Department of Local Government, (Planning Appeals Section), Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for outline permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
