(1) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.	(1) To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
(2) That the relocated sign be positioned within the curtilage of the applicant's holding and outside the limit of the Naas Road Improvement Scheme.	(2) In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area.

If there is no appeal to the Minister for Local Government against this decision ~~Permission~~ will be granted by the Council on the expiration of the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in accordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the ~~Permission~~ as soon as may be after the withdrawal.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary, Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for ~~Permission~~ as if it had been made to him in the first instance.

APPROVAL OF THE COUNCIL UNDER BUILDING BYE LAWS MUST BE OBTAINED BEFORE THE DEVELOPMENT IS COMMENCED AND THE TERMS OF APPROVAL MUST BE COMPLIED WITH IN THE CARRYING OUT OF THE WORK.

With reference to your letter dated 25th February, 1969, regarding planning permission in connection with above, I am to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, the following information must be submitted in triplicate:-

- (1) The location of the proposed dwelling clearly outlined on the site plan. (A minimum set-back of 30-ft. from road boundary to building line is required in this instance.
- (2) The layout of the access to the proposed dwelling giving adequate and safe approach to the public road.
- (3) The precise location of the proposed septic tank, together with the results of a trial hole, to be dug at this location and inspected by a Official of Dublin Health Authority (6, Parnell Square).
- (4) Design of the proposed septic tank.

NOTE: The applicant is advised to consult with the Dublin Health Authority, 6, Parnell Square, with regard to Conditions (3) and (4) above.
