In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order 1534 (A) dated 17th. April 1969 make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act refusing permission for:

for the following reasons:-

1. The proposed change of use would seriously injure the amenities of properties in the vicinity of the dwelling No 1 Cherrywood Park.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
