NOTIFICATION OF A DECISION ON AN APPLICATION FOR A PERMISSION

APPLICANT

South County Dublin Housing Society.

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/309/69 dated 7th March, 1969 make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act to grant a permission for:

Proposed Development of Twelve Houses off Church Road, Ballybrack.

Floor area: 12,900 sq.ft.

subject to the following conditions:-

Conditions:

- (1) That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
- (2) That the water and drainage arrangements shall be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
- (3) That Building Bye-Laws Approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

Reasons for conditions:

- (1) To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
- (2) In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
- (3) In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.

If there is no appeal to the Minister for Local Government against this decision, permission will be granted by the Council on the expiration of the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in accordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the permission as soon as may be after the withdrawal.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary, Department of Local Government, (Planning Appeals Section), Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.

Approval of the council under Building Bye Laws must be obtained and the terms of the approval must be complied with in the carrying out of the work before any development which may be permitted is commenced.

With reference to your letter of the 10th January, 1969, regarding planning permission in connection with above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, the following information must be submitted:

- (1) A revised layout with adequate provision for safe traffic movements and safety of school going children to and from the proposed site is required.
- (2) Revised proposals for the treatment and disposal of foul sewage are required.
- (3) A site location plan, showing the curtilage of the applicants holding is also required.

NOTE: The Applicants are advised to consult with the Council's Road Design Section and the Sanitary Authority (6, Parnell Square), together with the Sanitary Services Section (4, Parnell Square) with regard to the above requirements.
