APPEAL by Western Contractors Limited, of Greenhills Road, Walkinstown, Dublin, against the decision made on the 8th day of February, 1983, by the Council of the County of Dublin to refuse an outline permission for the erection of two service stations including canopies, shops and office stores in a site at the proposed Nangor Road Extension, Knockmitten, County Dublin:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1983, outline permission is hereby refused for the erection of the said service stations for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

- 1. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard in that it would generate additional traffic turning movements on the Nangor/Fox and Geese Road which is planned as a major distributor road carrying traffic from Clondalkin to Dublin city. The two additional access points proposed on this road, which has been designed with a limited number of access points, would tend to negate the value of the road as a major distributor carrying a heavy volume of traffic.
- 2. Pending the construction of the second carriageway of the Nangor/Fox and Geese Road the proposed development would lead to serious traffic hazard due to traffic turning movements crossing on-coming traffic and the inability of the planning authority to prevent such turning movements.
