- (1) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specifications lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
- (2) That the conditions imposed by the Minister for Local Government by order no. 23.6/1/764 dated 11th December, 1966 be strictly observed in respect of this proposal.
- (3) That the entrances and exits to and from each station be not wider than 20ft.
- (4) The street boundary of each station must be defined, except at openings with a wall or railing to a height of not less than 10ft 6ins. over the level of the adjoining roadway.
- (5) In the case of the station fronting on to the arterial route, the ground area on the south east boundary of the ¹⁸0.11/76 ^{to} submitted to Hutterfield Town Council boundary to provide an entrance width as specified in condition (3) above.
- (6) That planning bye-law approval shall be obtained and any conditions of approval be observed in the development.
