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That the development be carried out strictly in accordance with the plans and specification attached with the application.

That the roads, sewers, water mains and other services shall be on the plans, or referred for the development be constructed in accordance with Co. Council's specification for such services.

That the levels and alignment of the proposed ring road shall be approved by the Local Authority before any constructional work takes place.

That the Council should be taken in the development and alignment of this ring road and the overall development of the Council's proposal to lay a main trunk sewer through the site. For this purpose a wayleave will be required by the Council, which shall be required for by the Council.
