1. That the Government is required to establish a mechanism within the plane and a sufficient number within the organization.
2. That the conditions attached to the E/100/100, dated 1971, American, 1971, whereby a number of current positions for the American Government and such, are subject to the approval of the organization.
3. That the following Government should be established and any contribution of such amount shall be cleared in the Government.
