(1) Details of the layout plan, including any possible arrangements for the proposed development, to be submitted for the Council's consideration.

(2) Development and of the nature of the work to be carried out, including the availability of a layout plan for the proposed development, and the nature of the work.

(3) The need for a detailed scheme with the main north-south axis.

(4) The open space requirements of the Council, generally 10% of the area of the site, to be suitably located and distributed on the north side of the proposed plan.

(5) Detailed landscape plans for both the main and north-south axes, to be considered in consultation with the City Engineer, and the Council's requirements for the proposed plan.
