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housing development at Oldmans Road, Talleghy

- (1) That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as to the conditions hereunder otherwise required. (To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained).
- (2) That the outlet levels of the plant are arranged to enable a satisfactory link-up by gravity to the proposed Doherty Valley sewer.
- (3) That the capacity, design, construction, operation and maintenance of the proposed works be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. (In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964).
- (4) That a legally binding agreement be entered into between you and the Dublin County Council, whereby at your expense, the County Council will maintain the proposed Temporary Sewage Treatment Works, until such time as the outfall pipe from the development is connected into the proper Doherty Valley, Trunk Sewer. (In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts 1878 - 1964).
- (5) That the proposed treatment pH plant and disposal works be sited in accordance with the satisfaction of the County Council. (In the line of visual amenity).

(6) That the Council's proposal to lay the main trunk Doherty Valley sewer through portion of the site, for this purpose a bye-law will be required by the Council, which should be provided for by the developer. (Particulars of the location and other details of this trunk sewer may be obtained from the Sanitary Services Section of the County Council.

(7) That the conditions Nos. (2) & (3) specified in the application be great outline permission for the housing development by Order No. 18/002/67 be adhered to.

(8) That Building Bye-law approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development. (In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964).
