APPEAL by James and Rose Slevin of 228D Bunting Road, Walkinstown, Dublin, against the decision made on the 14th day of October, 1982, by the Council of the County of Dublin to grant subject to conditions a permission to Sheila Homes, 24, Hughes Road North, Walkinstown, Dublin for the erection of security fencing around an existing Scout Den at Bunting Road Extension, Walkinstown, Dublin in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1982, it is hereby decided, for the reason set out in the First Schedule hereto, to grant permission for the erection of the said fencing in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the condition specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, the reason for the imposition of the said condition being as set out in column 2 of the said Second Schedule and the said permission is hereby granted subject to the said condition.
