Dear Sir,

With reference to your planning application, received here on 23rd December, 1986, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you, that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963-1983, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. Further information is required which will provide for clarification of the relationship of the proposed new works to the existing house and the relationship of the proposed new drainage arrangements to any existing w.c. facilities that maybe located in the rear portion of the garage structure. Revised plans should clearly show the previously existing flat roof portion of the house together with any proposed extensions to the existing garage where it adjoins the neighbouring property boundary. Revised plans should show the proposed velux roof lights relocated on reverse roof pitch remote from adjoining property and the provision of obscure window glazing to new flank windows at flank ground floor level.
