1. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard because of the creation of a new access and additional traffic turning movements onto the heavily trafficked Lucan Road (N4), in close proximity to a bend where it would not be possible to provide adequate vision splays.
2. The site has inadequate road front and would represent undesirable backland development.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to An Bord Pleanala, Irish Life Centre, Dublin 1, and accompanied by a deposit of £10. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn, An Bord Pleanala will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
