3. That all external finishes harmonise in colour and texture with the existing premises.
4. Building line of 9 metres minimum to be provided.
5. Board of Works standards to be maintained.
6. The structure shall be removed on or before 1/9/'87, unless permission for their retention has been obtained from the County Council or from An Bord Pleanála on appeal.
