APPEAL by Maiden Poster Sites of 25 Upper Mount Street, Dublin against the decision made on the 6th day of September, 1982, by the Council of the County of Dublin to refuse permission for the erection of an advertising structure at 1 Wainsfort Drive, Terenure, Dublin.

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1982, permission is hereby refused for the erection of the said advertising structure for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The proposed advertising structure would face onto a public open space area and be fully in view from nearby residential properties and would, therefore, be seriously injurious to the visual amenities of the area.

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed sign is located on a gable wall facing onto the very heavily trafficked Wainsfort Road and would cause a distraction to motorists and would, therefore, endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard and would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.
2. The proposed advertisement sign would face onto a public open space, would be seriously injurious to the visual amenities of the area and would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.

An appeal against the decision may be made to An Bord Pleanála by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to An Bord Pleanála, Irish Life Centre, Dublin 1, and accompanied by a deposit of £10. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn, An Bord Pleanála will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
