In pursuance of its functions under the above-mentioned Acts, the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order, P/ 325/87 dated 29.1.87 decided to refuse:

For Proposed erection of sign at Balrothery Cross, Tallaght

for the following reasons:

1. The site is located within an area zoned in the Development Plan "to protect and improve high amenity areas". The proposed double sign, by reason of its size and obtrusive appearance, would materially contravene the above objective, would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area, and would be seriously injurious to the amenities of the area.

2. The proposed sign by reason of its size and obtrusive appearance immediately adjoining the Tallaght Bypass National Secondary Route would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because of the undue distraction to road users on the nearly constructed Tallaght Bypass National Secondary Route.

**IMPORTANT:**  
 NOTE: (1) An appeal against the decision may be made to An Bord Pleanala. The applicant may appeal within one month from the date of receipt by him of this notification. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of appeal and should be addressed to An Bord Pleanala, Irish Life Centre, Lower Abbey Street, Dublin 1. An appeal lodged by an applicant or his agent with An Bord Pleanala will be invalid unless accompanied by a fee of £36. (Thirty-six pounds). (2) A party to an appeal making a request to An Bord Pleanala for an oral hearing of an appeal must, in addition to (1) above, pay to An Bord Pleanala a fee of £36. (Thirty-six pounds). (3) A person who is not a party to an appeal must pay a fee of £10 (Ten pounds) to An Bord Pleanala in relation to an appeal. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn, An Bord Pleanala will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
