With reference to your planning application, received here on 21st October, 1986, (Time Extension up to 27/2/87), in connection with the above, I wish to inform you, that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963-1983, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

- 1. Clarification of the blue area shown on drawing No. 8626/20, and its use in relation to the necessary noise and distance setbacks from the proposed road boundaries at the south and west sides of the site. Clarification of specific proposals for revisions to the housing and open space layout, taking into account the foregoing matters, are required. The corrected overall site area should be clearly shown outlined in red. A copy of DP87/33 is attached in relation to the correct road proposals affecting the site. relation to the correct road proposals affecting the site.
 - 2. As the proposed direct access from the Distributor Road connecting Scholarstown Road with the Motorway Interchange is not acceptable, revised plans showing a temporary main access from Scholarstown Road, immediately west of Scholarstown House, with provision for adequate traffic visibility clearances acceptable to the Roads Department, and taking into account the Council's major proposals for the roundabout and link from Scholarstown Road to the Motorway Interchange are required. These revisions are to clearly show the lands and ownership of "Scholarstown House" curtilage together with the availability of adequate traffic visibility clearances.
 - 3. Specific proposals for internal foul and surface water drainage arrangements, taking into account the necessity for ensuring that the existing large watermains traversing the site will be protected from interference or damage.
