

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1983, permission is hereby refused for the said development for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

- The proposed development is located in an area zoned as zoning objective A "to protect and/or improve residential amenities", in the Dublin County Development Plan 1983. This zoning objective is considered reasonable and the proposal would contravene this zoning objective and would thus be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard as it would generate additional traffic movements and interfere with the safety and free flow of traffic on the heavily trafficked and substandard N4 Dublin/Sligo National Primary Route.
- 3. The proposed development is considered to be unacceptable as no private open space has been provided to serve the proposed residential apartment.
