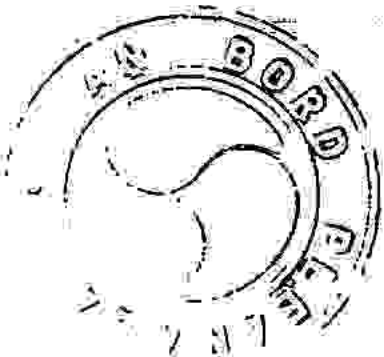

APPEAL by David Allen Holdings Limited of 25, Upper Mount Street, Dublin, against the decision made on the 25th day of September, 1986, by the Council of the County of Dublin to refuse a permission for the retention of two advertising structures at land known as Fox and Geese, Naas Road, County Dublin:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1983, permission is hereby refused for retention of the said advertising structures for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

The signs, the subject of this appeal, are unrelated to any local enterprise or business and, by reason of their size, content and prominent location, constitute a discordant and visually obtrusive feature along this section of Naas Road and it is considered, accordingly, that retention of the signs would be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.

NOTE: (1) An appeal against the decision may be made to An Bord Pleanala. The applicant may appeal within one month from the date of receipt by him of this notification. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of appeal and should be addressed to *An Bord Pleanala, Irish Life Centre, Lower Abbey Street, Dublin 1*. An appeal lodged by an applicant or his agent with An Bord Pleanala will be invalid unless accompanied by a fee of £36. (Thirty-six pounds). (2) A party to an appeal making a request to An Bord Pleanala for an oral hearing of an appeal must, in addition to (1) above, pay to An Bord Pleanala a fee of £36. (Thirty-six pounds). (3) A person who is not a party to an appeal must pay a fee of £10 (Ten pounds) to An Bord Pleanala in relation to an appeal. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn, An Bord Pleanala will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
