### REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specification lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.

2. That before development commences, approval under the Building Bye-laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.

3. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.

4. That the temporary classrooms be removed on or before the 4th September, 1989, unless before that date permission for their retention is granted by the Planning Authority or by An Bord Pleanála on appeal.

5. That the proposed structure harmonise in colour and with the existing premises.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.

2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.

3. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.

4. To enable the effect of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed having regard to the conditions then obtaining.
