

With reference to your planning application, received here on 30th June, 1986, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963-1983, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

- 1. The applicant to submit specific details of their proposals for foul and surface water drainage in view of the stated intention to drain to a public sewer. The nearest public sewer is a minimum of \$30m from the site and located in private land and the applicant may not be able to achieve the necessary gradients for the size of pipe to be used.
- 2. Specific proposals for the provision of an adequate and suitable water supply are required to be submitted.
