APPEAL by Pascal Hosford, of 136 Saint John's Meadows, Clondalkin, Dublin, on behalf of Saint John's Meadows/Green Park Residents Association, against the decision made on the 14th day of August, 1986, by the Council of the County of Dublin, to grant subject to conditions a permission for the retention of two sets of temporary traffic bollards at Saint John's Park East and Saint John's Park West, Clondalkin, to Saint John's Park Residents Association, care of Paula Brady, of 55 Saint John's Park, Clondalkin, Dublin, in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1983, it is hereby decided, for the reason set out in the First Schedule hereto, to grant permission for retention of the said two sets of temporary traffic bollards in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the condition specified in the Second Schedule hereto, the reason for the imposition of the said condition being as set out in the said Second Schedule and the said permission is hereby granted subject to the said condition.


FIRST SCHEDULE

It is considered that, subject to compliance with the conditions set out in the Second Schedule hereto, the proposed development would be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.

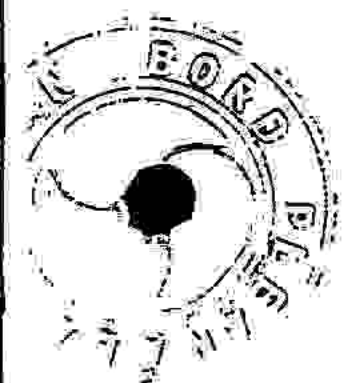
SECOND SCHEDULE

The bollards shall be removed within two years of the date of this order or when the Newlands Fonthill Road becomes operational, whichever is the earlier date and the carriageway and footpaths shall be reinstated in accordance with the detailed requirements of the planning authority, unless before that date permission for their further retention is granted by the planning authority, or by An Bord Pleanála on appeal.
