APPEAL by Richard Morton, care of Martin E. Marren and Company, 2/4 Lower O'Connell Street, Dublin, against the decision made on the 9th day of July, 1986, by the Council of the County of Dublin, to grant subject to conditions a permission for the erection of a new boundary fence and new carparking area at Holy Family National School, Rathcoole, County Dublin to L.O'Sullivan on behalf of the Holy Family National School, in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1983, it is hereby decided, for the reason set out in the First Schedule hereto, to grant permission for the said fence and carparking area, in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the conditions specified in the Second Schedule hereto, the reasons for the imposition of the said conditions being as set out in the said Second Schedule and the said permission is hereby granted subject to the said conditions.

FIRST SCHEDULE

The proposed development carried out in accordance with the conditions set out in the Second Schedule would not be injurious to the amenities of the area or constitute a traffic hazard and would be consistent with the proper planning and development of the area.

SECOND SCHEDULE

1. The new entrance shall be recessed 4 metres from the front boundary and wing walls shall be splayed at an angle of 45 degrees and shall not exceed 1 metre in height.

Reason: In the interest of traffic safety.

2. The wing walls shall match the existing boundary wall in material and construction.

Reason: In the interest of visual amenity.
