With reference to your planning application, received here on 14th April, 1986, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you, that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963-1983, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. Applicants to submit details of the exact location of the different structures proposed, relative to the stream, clearly indicating any proposed obstructions to the flow thereof and possible resultant flooding upstream during spate conditions or erosion of the stream bed or banks downstream. These matters are to be the subject of consultation and agreement with the Sanitary Services Department before the submission of any additional information.
