Dear Sir,

With reference to your planning application received here on 4th June, 1982 in connection with the above, I wish to inform you, that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, the following additional information must be in submitted in quadruplicate:-

- 1. The pollution resulting from the pperation of the chimney stack is unacceptable to the Supervising Health Inspector on a number of grounds viz:-
- (1) The ladd levels in the air measured at Fischer metals arranged 7.8ug/m for the period 27.5.82-30.6.82 (34 days), The EEC standard for lead in air is 2ug/m annual mean.
- (2) The acidity of the exhaust games is excessive.
- (3) There has been an increase of 64% registered at the smoke and SO" station at Monastery Road, Clondalkin over the period 1980-82 and it would appear that the chimney might be contributing greatly to this increase.

The applicants should indicate if they are in a position to take steps to rectify the above mateers.
