Conditions	Reasons for Conditions
1. The development to be carried out in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.	To comply with permission regulations.
2. The proposed side panels shall be completely omitted from the bus shelter.	To maintain an acceptable foot-path width and to protect public safety.
3. The following requirements of the Engineering Department (Roads) to be complied with: a) Any damage to footpath and/or carriageway resulting from building works to be repaired by the Corporation at the developers expense. b) Armoured unbreakable glass to be used in the construction of shelter in the interest of the safety of pedestrians and other road users.	To ensure an acceptable standard of development.
4. The applicants shall make satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance repair and upkeep of the structure.	In the interest of amenity and public safety.
5. The applicants shall accept responsibility for the removal of the structure at their own expense, if such is necessary for the purposes of road widening, reconstruction or repair, and for the repair, replacement and renewal of any service installed in the public street.	In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area.
