REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.

2. That the applicant indemnify the County Council against any claim made against the Authority as a result of the presence of the structure on a public property.

2. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

3. That the applicant makes satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure.

In the interest of amenity and public safety.

4. That the applicants accept responsibility for the removal of the structure at his own expense, if such is necessary, for the purpose of road widening, reconstruction or repair and for the repair, replacement and renewal of any services installed in the public street.

4. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

5. That the lighting of the panels be so carried out as not to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users or adjoining property owners and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights.

5. In the interest of public safety and amenity.

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6. That the precise location of the bus shelter be agreed with the Planning Authority prior to the commencement of development. In relation to the location of the bus shelter there is a current application for a petrol station on land to the east with an access proposed where the bus shelter is indicated. The bus shelter would therefore have to be moved so that it would not interfere with this proposed access. In the event of a permission being granted for the petrol station.
