
SCHEDULE

- 1. The site is in the Dublin Mountain zone in an area designated in the County Development Plan as one of high scenic amenity. It is the policy of the planning authority that any development in this area not directly related to its amenity potential or its use for agriculture, mountain or hill farming, should be prohibited. This policy is considered reasonable and the proposed development would be in conflict with it, and, accordingly, be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- 2. The site is located in an area served by an extremely sub-standard road network, with narrow widths and inadequate sight distances on many corners. Taken in conjunction with existing development in the vicinity, the proposed development would result in an excessive density of development in an unserviced rural area.
