CONDITIONS

REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

1. The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.
2. That before development commences, approval under the Building Bye-Laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.
3. That the requirements of the Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Niece Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
5. That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. In this respect surface water is to be drained separately to the existing surface water sewer in the roadway outside the site.
6. That a plan for car parking to serve the development be submitted to and agreed with the Planning authority prior to commencement of development.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
3. In the interest of health.
4. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
5. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
6. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
