1. The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.

2. That the bollards shall be removed after 1 year from the date of this order unless before that time permission for their retention has been obtained from the Planning Authority or An Bord Pleanála on appeal.

Note: In view of the restrictions on the existing road network caused by the bollards, it is unlikely that the Planning Authority would grant permission for the retention of the bollards after 1 year.
