That the water supply and drainage arrangements including design and location of septic tank and disposal area be in accordance with the requirements of the Sanitary Authority. In this regard the applicant is advised to consult with the NEH Supervising Health Inspector, Eastern Health Board, 33 Gardiner Place, Dublin 1, Phone 787777. 5. That the external finishes, including the roof be the subject of consultation and agreement with the Planning Authority before construction commences. Roof finishes should be provided for dark blue, slate or blue/black colours. 6. In the event of the applicant connecting with the Dublin County Council watermain a financial contribution in the sum of £250. to be paid prior to any such connection.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained. 2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts 1878-1964. 3.
