for the following reasons:

1. The proposed signs by virtue of their size and location/^{on} the heavily trafficked N7, National Primary Route would cause a distraction to road users thus endangering public safety by reason of a traffic hazard.
2. The proposed signs are located in an area zoned in the Development Plan "to protect and provide for the development of agriculture". The development proposed would be seriously injurious to the amenities of this rural area and would not be in the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

NOTE: (1) An appeal against the decision may be made to An Bord Pleanala. The applicant may appeal within one month from the date of receipt by him of this notification. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of appeal and should be addressed to An Bord Pleanala, Irish Life Centre, Lower Abbey Street, Dublin 1. An appeal lodged by an applicant or his agent with An Bord Pleanala will be invalid unless accompanied by a fee of £36. (Thirty-six pounds). (2) A party to an appeal making a request to An Bord Pleanala for an oral hearing of an appeal must, in addition to (1) above, pay to An Bord Pleanala a fee of £36. (Thirty-six pounds). (3) A person who is not a party to an appeal must pay a fee of £10 (Ten pounds) to An Bord Pleanala in relation to an appeal. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn, An Bord Pleanala will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
