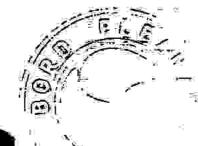
DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1983, permission is hereby refused for the said restaurant extension for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

- The proposed significant intensification of development on this site would endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard due to the generation of increased traffic-turning movements on the N.7 National Primary Route.
- The site of the proposed development is situated in a rural area zoned in the Development Plan with the objective to protect and provide for the development of agriculture. The development proposed, by reason of its excessive scale, would significantly change the character of the existing development and so would contravene materially the zoning objective for the area and would be seriously injurious to the amenities of the area.
