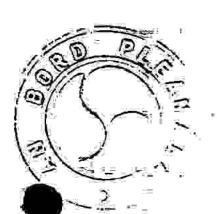
SCHEDULE

 of traffic hazard because the proximity of the proposed entrances
 to the existing entrance to the north-west and an access lane
 to the south-east, both on the sub-standard Nangor Road, would
 generate conflicting traffic turning movements.
