1. The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.
2. That before development commences, approval under the Building Bye-Laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.
3. That a scheme for the planting, landscaping of the area on the inside of the fence shall be submitted to and agreed with the planning Authority prior to the commencement of development.
4. That the fencing shall be black in colour.
5. That the location of the boundary of the site along the line of the new road and Newcastle Road be set out by the applicant on site and checked by the Roads Engineer prior to commencement of development.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
3. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
4. In the interest of visual amenity.
5. To ensure a satisfactory standard of development.
