CONDITIONS

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, that the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That before development commences, approval under the Building Bye-Laws to be obtained and all conditions of that approval to be observed in the development.
3. That the requirements of the St Chief Medical Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
4. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
5. That water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of Sanitary Authority. In this respect applicant to submit details of proposed connection to watermain.
6. That carparking for both the existing and proposed developments be provided.
7. That details of the proposed landscaping and planting boundary along the northern boundary of the site be agreed with the Planning Authority prior to the commencement of development.
