1. Subject to the conditions of this permission, that the development be strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application. 2. That the use shall be discontinued not later than the 31st July, 1987, unless by that date permission for the continuance of the use for a further period has been granted by the Planning Authority or By An Bord Pleanála on appeal. 3. That the first floor accommodation be maintained for residential purposes and not for commercial or industrial activities. 4. That the use permitted by this permission for the ground floor portion shall continue only for so long as the dental surgery activities are carried on by the present applicant.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission, and that effective control be maintained. 2. To enable the effects of the development of the amenity of the area to be reviewed having regard to the conditions then obtaining. 3. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area. 4. To prevent unauthorised development.
