
Dear Sir,

With reference to your planning application received here on 20th April, 1982, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning & Development) Acts, 1963 & 1976, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. The applicants should submit evidence of their legal interest in the site.
2. Accesses to the site shown to be from the Dublin Corporation area. Planning permission must be obtained for these access points and a copy of said permission submitted as part of this planning application.
3. The layout proposed on the site and the position of the building has not been agreed with Dublin Corporation who claim to be the owners of the site. An agreed layout should be submitted following discussion with Dublin Corporation Parks Department and the Civic and Amenities Architect, Dublin Corporation.
4. A schedule of the proposed uses of the complex building should be submitted.
5. The Sanitary Services which will facilitate this development are from the Dublin Corporation system. Confirmation is required that Dublin Corporation have agreed to provide these services.
6. Confirmation is required that there will be no interference with the two County Council sewers which traverse the site. These sewers should be identified on the lodged plans.
