for the following reasons:-

(1) The development for service station, repairs, showrooms and sales purposes, as now proposed, is in excess of the previous proposals for a petrol filling station on portion of this site, which was the subject of a grant of Special Permission by Order No. 32/532/57, dated 12th December, 1957, at the approach ~~to~~ ^{to be stopped} major junction on the Blessington Road and would create a serious traffic hazard, by reason of the increased vehicular movements to and from the site, at the east approach to and immediately adjoining the proposed major junction.

(2) The proposed design of septic tank is not acceptable to the County Council, and is likely to create a health hazard.

(3) The plans submitted do not indicate that adequate water pressure can be obtained to serve the proposal, so as to provide for adequate water supply for both domestic and fire fighting purposes.
