CONDITIONS.

- (1) Subject to condition (2) and the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer, the Chief Medical Officer, the Engineering Department and/or the building bye-laws, the development to be carried out in conformity with the plans and specifications to which this application relates. Approval under the building bye-laws to be obtained and all conditions of approval to be observed in the development. (To achieve a satisfactory standard of construction and to prevent unauthorised development).
- (2) The timber post and chain link fence along the perimeter of the car park site to be omitted and in lieu an 18" dwarf wall with coping to be erected. Evergreen trees at 10ft. intervals to be planted along the perimeter of the car park, (To improve the visual amenities of the area).
- (3) All surface water must be trapped and discharged into drains within the curtilage of the site. Gradient of car parking area shall not be steeper than 1 in 40 for a minimum distance of 20ft. immediately and radially inside front boundary gateway. Gates in front boundary must be designed not to open outwards over the public footpath. The footpath opposite new gateway must be reconstructed at proposer's expense by Paving Department. (To achieve a satisfactory standard of development).
- (4) The use of the site as a car park to be discontinued prior to 1st August, 1973 unless before that date permission for retention for a further period has been granted by the Corporation. (To conform to the terms of the application)
