APPEAL by the Irish Life Assurance Company Limited, of Irish Life Centre, Lower Abbey Street, Dublin against the decision made on the 24th day of June, 1982, by the Council of the County of Dublin to refuse permission for the retention of an advertising structure on a site at the junction of Mayberry Road and Belgard Road, Tallaght, County Dublin.
