1. That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application.
2. That the front building line of the proposed houses be set not less than 25-ft. from the boundary of Primrose Lane.
3. That a 6' high screen wall, suitably capped and finished, be provided along the north side boundary of No. 1.
4. That Building Bye-Laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.
5. That the existing open stream along the front boundary of the site be properly culverted with an adequate sized conduit in accordance with the Engineering requirements of the Council.
6. That a footpath 6'0" wide be provided in accordance with the Council's specification for such works, along the frontage of the sites 1 to 4 and that the front boundary wall be set back accordingly to allow
