- (1) That the development be carried out in complete conformity with the plan and specifications lodged with the application, save as in the conditions hereinafter otherwise required.
- (2) That the extent of the proposed factory estate roads, sewers, waterworks and other services necessary to serve factory sites shall be strictly limited by this provision to that required to serve factories, the total quantity of sewage from which, shall not exceed the figure laid down in the conditions imposed on the industrial permission by Order dated 15th June 1906, which states as follows:—
"That the quantity of sewage passed through the sewer and detention tank shall not exceed 1,000 gallons per day, no trade waste or effluent shall be discharged into the sewer or the detention tank and the discharge from the detention tank shall be regulated so as to come to night over a period of not less than three hours (the present limit to public health which would result from the following sewage disposal works)".
- (3) That the terms of the conditions imposed by Industrial permission by Order dated 15th June 1906, and required in (2) above, in respect of trade waste and regulation of discharge from the detention tank of sewage be complied with in the development.
- (4) That the overall width of the factory estate shall be 30-ft consisting of a carriage-way 24-ft wide, a foot-path 6-ft wide on each side of the carriage-way and a grass verge 7-ft wide on each side of the carriage-way, the grass verges to be situated between the footpaths and the carriage-way.
- (5) That the standards of construction of the roads and services are properly in accordance with engineering requirements of the Council generally for such areas and that the depth and width of construction of the carriage-way and vehicular ways, in particular, be adequate to withstand industrial traffic.
- (6) That building bye-laws approved shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.
