In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/1235/67 dated 10th November 1967 make a decision pursuant to Section 26(1) of the Act refusing permission for:

Use of Land for Flaying Pitches and Erection of Dressing Rooms at

Clonburris, 9th Lock, Clondalkin. Floor area - 545 sq.ft

for the following reasons:-

- (1) The proposed development is located on the Council's land which was acquired for the Council's housing purposes and the land may be developed for this purpose during 1968.

**Note:** The present tenant of the land holds same on a limited grazing letting and has no right to sub let any part of the land to a third party.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
