In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/876/67 dated Sth September 1967 make a decision pursuant to Section 26 (1) of the Act to grant an outline permission for:

Housing Development at Newcastle

subject to the following conditions:-

- (I) That no constructional work takes place until detailed plums have been submitted to and approved by the Council under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963.
- (2) That the front building line of the proposed houses shall be not less than 30-ft from the road boundary fence.
- (3) That the junction of the rere access lane with the County road be such as to provide adequate vision in the interest of road safety and that the laneway be not less than 12-ft minimum width and have adequate turning facility at its terminus.

If there is no appeal to the Minister for Local Government against this decision, outline permission will be granted by the Council on the expiration of the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in accordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the outline permission as soon as may be after the withdrawal.
